

## LIVER FLUKE RAPID ANTIBODY TEST for CATTLE





For use by Vets, Farmers and Livestock Handlers




- Each test is a single use test. Dispose after use. Each lateral flow device can only be used once.
- Use within one hour of opening.
- Do not use after the expiry date.
- Store at room temperature (15° 25°C).
- The test is designed for use with blood, but can used with plasma or serum.


## SPECIMEN COLLECTION AND HANDLING



Blood can be collected from the top of the nose (or the ear if necessary). If sampling from the nose, a dosing yolk to help restrain the animal's head is recommended.

Dry the top of the nose with a clean tissue, just where the hair meets the skin of the nose.





Wait 15 secs for the blood droplet to appear (2) before taking sample.

Gently collect blood sample in end of collection loop (3).


Remove the whole sample buffer bottle lid (white), insert blood collection sample and

swirl.











Remove the lateral flow device from the foil pouch and ensure that the desiccant sachet is orange. (If green, discard and use new device).



















10 minutes before reading the test result.

## INTERPRETATION OF TEST RESULTS

After 10 minutes evaluate the lateral flow device for the formation of a control line (C). If there is no visible control line the test is invalid.

If a control line (C) is visible, use the reference card to match up the colour of the **test line (T)** and assign a score to the test line. If there is no visible (T) line after 10 minutes, the animal has tested negative. If there any visible (T) line results, discuss with your vet.



Test score indications: O = Negative 1 = Inconclusive 2-10 = Positive
