DOSAGE

For puppies and small dogs up to 4 kg bodyweight	Use 1 PIPETTE of MOXICLEAR FOR PUPPIES AND SMALL DOGS UP TO 4 KG
For dogs 4-10 kg	Use 1 PIPETTE of MOXICLEAR FOR DOGS
bodyweight	4–10 KG
For dogs 10-25 kg	Use 1 PIPETTE of MOXICLEAR FOR DOGS
bodyweight	10-25 KG
For dogs over 25 kg	Use 1 PIPETTE of MOXICLEAR FOR DOGS

For very large dogs over 50 kg, apply 2 pipettes of MOXICLEAR for Dogs Over 25 kg by dividing the dose between the shoulder blades, on the midline of the back between the hips, and at one point in between.

- 1. Remove the pipette from the outer sachet using scissors or fold along diagonal line to expose nick; tear back at nick.
- 2. Hold the pipette upright.
- 3. Tap the narrow part of the pipette to ensure the contents remains within the main body of the pipette.
- 4. Twist or snap back the tip.
- 5. Site of Application.

- 6. The animal should be standing for easy application. Part the hair until the skin is visible. Place the tip of the pipette on the skin and squeeze the pipette firmly twice to apply the solution directly on the skin. Avoid pet's eyes or mouth.
- 7. Record treatment date and repeat monthly or as directed.
- The solvent in MOXICLEAR may mark certain materials including plastics, leather, fabrics and finished surfaces. Allow application site to dry before permitting contact with such materials.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

FLEA CONTROL AND PREVENTION

MOXICLEAR has been shown experimentally to kill adult and larval fleas within 20 minutes. Death can occur due to contact by absorption via the flea intersegmental membranes. Stops fleas from feeding in 3-5 minutes. Fleas are not required to bite to receive a lethal dose.

MOXICLEAR can be used as part of a treatment strategy for flea allergy dermatitis (FAD). MOXICLEAR breaks the FAD cycle by eliminating fleas which are the cause. Animals with severe FAD may require additional veterinary treatment.

It is recommended that all dogs in the same environment should be protected by MOXICLEAR for dogs. Additionally all cats should be protected with MOXICLEAR for cats. MOXICLEAR may be used as the only product for flea control as it breaks the life cycle and kills fleas emerging from the environment to reinfest the dog. New fleas may continue to emerge from the environment for six weeks or longer (depending on climate) after treatment is initiated.



More rapid resolution of heavy environmental infestations may be obtained by additional environmental control measures using a suitable registered product. Exposure of dogs to water or shampooing 4 hours after treatment does not reduce the effectiveness of MOXICLEAR. Frequent swimming or washing can shorten the duration of flea control.

WORM CONTROL

MOXICLEAR controls the major gastrointestinal nematodes of dogs but does not control tapeworms. In order to control tapeworms use specific agent. Dogs can become reinfested with worms but regular use of MOXICLEAR will remove them.

If worm problems persist consult a veterinarian.

TREATMENT AND CONTROL OF EAR MITES

For the elimination of ear mites (*Otodectes cynotis*), MOXICLEAR should be applied once and is highly efficacious as a single dose. Animals not responding to the initial treatment may respond to a second monthly treatment. Such non responding animals should be monitored and veterinary advice sought if treatment is not successful. Monthly application of MOXICLEAR will treat any subsequent ear mite infestation. To maximise efficacy gentle cleaning of the ear canal is recommended.

TREATMENT AND CONTROL OF SARCOPTIC MANGE

MOXICLEAR has been shown to have good efficacy against sarcoptic mites (Sarcoptes scabiei) after a single dose. A second dose of MOXICLEAR a month later will result in continued improvement of the clinical signs associated with sarcoptic mange. Monthly application of MOXICLEAR will control any subsequent sarcoptic mite infestation.

AN AID IN THE TREATMENT AND CONTROL OF GENERALISED DEMODICOSIS

MOXICLEAR may be effective in the treatment of generalised demodicosis when administered at monthly intervals for 2 to 4 treatments.

LICE CONTROL

A single treatment of MOXICLEAR will control lice on dogs.

PUPPIES

Puppies may be treated with MOXICLEAR For Puppies and Small Dogs up to 4 kg from 7 weeks of age. If puppies younger than 7 weeks require flea control they may be safely treated with an alternative imidacloprid only ectoparasiticide. When worming puppies prior to commencing MOXICLEAR, use a specific worming agent at 2, 3, 4, and 6 weeks of age. Once treatment with MOXICLEAR every month is commenced worms will be continuously controlled.

PRECAUTIONS

Do not apply MOXICLEAR FOR DOGS to cats. Use with caution in sick, debilitated or underweight animals.

PREGNANCY AND LACTATION

No primary embryo-toxic, teratogenic or reproductive toxic effects have been observed with imidacloprid or moxidectin in laboratory species. Evidence suggests that no adverse effects are to be expected in pregnant and lactating dogs. However, the safety of MOXICLEAR has not been established during pregnancy and lactation.

ADVERSE EVENTS

In extremely rare cases, application site disorders such as hair loss, redness and itching may occur.

STORAGE

Store below 25°C and protect from light.
